This legislation would fully reauthorize and strengthen the existing Runaway and Homeless Youth Act (RHYA) programs, administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, to prevent trafficking, identify survivors, and provide services to runaway, homeless, and disconnected youth. Through the excellent work of local street outreach, shelter, transitional housing, and maternity group homes, RHYA helps youth experiencing homelessness access education, employment, and family reconnection services.

Now is the time for you and other members of Congress to act to help our young people. Together, we can create a safer and more promising future for our youth, break the cycle of homelessness, and provide them with the tools to thrive. That is why I am asking you to cosponsor the Runaway and Homeless Youth and Trafficking Prevention Act of 2023.
